LITTLE OAKS

Paediatric Oncology Shared Care Unit (POSCU)



Little Oaks is a shared care oncology unit for children and young people aged 0 – 18 years. We are located on Oak Ward.

We have Monday to Friday paediatric oncology clinical nurse specialist cover. Lizzie Sturt who works Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and Susan Snaith who works Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Lizzie and Susan are chemotherapy trained. Our chemotherapy clinic is held on a Wednesday.

Your Lead Paediatric Consultant is Dr. Bhatti and his Deputy is Dr. Hatahet. They are both responsible for the care of your child at St. Peter's Hospital.

We are open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday 9am – 5pm. On a Thursday we are open 9am- 2.30pm.

We share care with the Royal Marsden Hospital, Great Ormond Street Hospital and University College London Hospitals (UCLH). This means that wherever possible, your child's chemotherapy or other treatments e.g. blood transfusion, platelet transfusion and intravenous antibiotics will be given here at St. Peter's Hospital. You may receive a shared care folder from your primary hospital. If so, please bring this with you so it can be completed during your attendance on Little Oaks / Ash Ward.

If your child is unwell, or if you have any concerns about your child, please ring Little Oaks immediately. You may be asked to bring your child in for a review with our Paediatric Consultant / Registrar.

If Little Oaks is not available for any reason then there are experienced nurses on Ash Ward who will be happy to help.

We liaise regularly with your primary hospital as well as the other services available at St. Peter's Hospital. For example:

- Pharmacist – advises on medications including chemotherapy
- Physiotherapist – referrals can be made to the physiotherapist if required to offer support with exercise and therapy
- Community Nursing Team – will provide support and nursing care at home and will liaise with the Trust's hospital teams

If your child attends Little Oaks or is an inpatient on Ash Ward, there are a variety of toys, games and DVD's available. Food and snacks are also provided for children during their stay, but you are more than welcome to bring your own food along. A microwave and tea/coffee facilities are available onsite. In addition, parking permits are available whilst your child is undergoing treatment at St. Peter's Hospital. Please ask one of the nurses on Little Oaks about how you can obtain one.

We are supported by the charity 'Momentum' who provide a family support worker, holiday cabins, special days out, massage therapy and music therapy. They also have a dedicated psychologist who works closely with families.
